Your valid state tax number, (certificate of resale) is required for our records.

A 2% per month finance charge will be added to accounts over 60 days.

Payments received on account will be credited to finance charges first, then to invoices according to ship date.

Plants not picked up or received within one month of original pick-up date or delivery date must be paid for in full or will be returned to inventory and made available for sale to other customers.
